Dear Wheeler Heights Parents and Carers,

I would like to again, thank you for your ongoing support and patience at this time of uncertainty with the COVID-19 pandemic.

Our school is still fully operational and therefore teaching and learning are occurring as normal.

There are additional changes to our school programs and coordination.

1. **PCS Extension Test** (for Year 6 students who nominated) scheduled for Thursday has been postponed (date TBA).
2. **All Band rehearsals** and **private tutoring** have been cancelled until further notice.
3. **Junior and Senior Dance** is cancelled until further notice.
4. **Yoga** lessons cancelled until further notice.
5. **Uniform Shop** will not open on Fridays until further notice. Orders can still be made online and will be delivered to students on Fridays. ****The planned 2nd Hand Uniforms Sale will continue next term or when the Uniform Shop can reopen**.**

As stated yesterday, **any students who present with any flu like symptoms or who are feeling unwell are asked to remain at home** and their parents should seek the advice of a medical practitioner. Please advise the school of the GP's recommendations.

Steps that can be taken to reduce the risk of infection



1. **Wash your hands** regularly and thoroughly.
