The purpose of our P&C to bring the community together and raise funds for our school. This year we held the **Kindy welcome event** down at Manly United soccer field which provided an opportunity for new parents to our school to get to know each other. We organized **Mothers and Father's Day events**, **school disco**, the bi-annual **color run**, our first and hopefully not last **outdoor movie night** and this past weekend the much-anticipated **trivia night** was held down at Dee Why RSL.

This year I was also lucky enough to assist the school again as the Parent Representative on Selection panels for the hiring of our new Assistant Principal for Curriculum and Instruction.

At the beginning of this year the P&C committed to raising a mammoth \$40,000 to support the school with Numeracy and Literacy resources and to start working on the upgrading the veggie garden. This past year we have already committed to purchasing \$20k of reading material to assist our teachers and children in the class and in addition we committed to repairing the K-2 playground net at a cost of \$15K.
